Getting here

Plenty of parking is available nearby at the Murwillumbah Showgrounds on Queensland Road, and we're within walking distance of the town center and Knox Park. Accessible spots are located at the Ewing Street end of Queensland Road.

Welcome Desks

Look out for our Welcome Desks at both ends of the Street Party. Our friendly staff and volunteers in bright pink t-shirts are ready to help with directions or any questions. They'll be roaming around too, so feel free to ask for assistance anytime.

Museum Entry

Enter the Museum via the front entrance, either up the stairs from Queensland Road or up the Bent Street incline through the courtyard. Our volunteers are on hand if you need any assistance. Pram Valet: To help manage crowds, leave your pram with our staff near the Adventure Game station. You'll get a ticket and can collect it when you exit the Museum.

Food & drinks

Stay refreshed at our water station and treat yourself to delicious bites from Kat Harvey Cheese, Parilya Eatery, Iced Tea Company, Oki Foods, Yulli's, Khanthaly's Kitchen, Hap's Health Bar, and Flyin' Fox Icy Poles.

Please note, alcohol cannot be brought into the event, but our licensed Swamp Beer Garden will be responsibly serving 1.30pm to 6.45pm for everyone's enjoyment.

Bring a picnic blanket or chair and relax on the grassy areas throughout the event.

Accessibility

Queensland Road is mostly flat, with a slight dip near Makers Lane. The Museum is fully wheelchair accessible, with a platform lift to the mezzanine level.

Toilets

Public toilets are available inside the Museum, including an accessible option. Additional outdoor toilets are located behind the stage at Ewing Street and near Makers Lane, with accessible facilities at both locations.
